## **WDVIP Program Objectives**

- To assist women in understanding that acts of violence can be a means of controlling the actions, thoughts, and feelings of others.
- To examine the **belief system** from which each woman operates in regard to the violence in her life.
- To increase the woman's understanding of the causes of violence by examining its cultural and social contexts.
- To increase each woman's understanding of the negative effects that violence has on her intimate relationships, children, family, friends and herself.
- To increase the options for each woman to remain violence-free.
- To provide practical information on how abusive behavior can be changed by exploring non-controlling and non-violent behavior.
- To provide information on local resources that can be used to develop a safety plan and/or social support system.
- To provide accurate information that addresses the myths and realities of domestic violence.
- To provide information about the effects of violence on **children** and to offer options for non-violent parenting.
- To enable each participant develop a personalized action plan for eliminating violence in relationships.

The WDVIP program consists of an extensive individual assessment and 26 group sessions.
