**The Diane Carter Memorial Fund
Donates \$15,000 to Family Service of the Piedmont's Clara House**

Greensboro, NC – September 21, 2017 – The Trustees of the Diane Carter Memorial Fund have generously donated \$15,000 to the Family Service of the Piedmont's Clara House shelter.

Diane Carter, a Greensboro native, was killed in 2002 in a terrorist bombing attack at the Hebrew University in Israel. A graduate of Duke University, Diane was employed at the library at Hebrew University when the attack occurred. The Diane Carter Memorial Fund was established to support causes in her honor.

Clara House, one of Family Service's two shelters for battered women and their children, is based in Greensboro provides a stable, supportive environment in which victims and their families can begin to rebuild their lives. Services offered at the shelter include a crisis line, counseling services, court advocacy, case management and continuation of care for when a woman is ready to leave the shelter.

Family Service of the Piedmont, is a private nonprofit agency providing quality support services, advocacy and education for children and adults dealing with domestic violence, child abuse, mental health and financial stability.
