Child Trauma-Focused Therapist

The agency is seeking a **Child/Trauma-Focused Outpatient Mental Health Therapist** to provide individual, group and family therapy to children and families who have been impacted by trauma. Join our team and be part of Family Service of the Piedmont's exciting new Center for Child Wellness which will uniquely combine psychiatric, therapeutic and case management services to establish a replicable model for best practice child psychiatric and wellness service delivery that can be used across the state and country.

Responsibilities:

1. Provide quality, culturally sensitive, respectful treatment services to a diverse population by using individual, family and group modalities.
2. Document all treatment services as required by agency and ethical standards.
3. Willingness to participate in learning collaboratives or other trainings to ensure delivery of best practice services.
4. Maintain harmonious relationships with community organizations by providing professional liaison concerning specific cases when indicated, and by providing consultation and advocacy when appropriate.
5. Plan, coordinate, and facilitate children's groups as designated.
6. Present at team case review meetings or Multi-Disciplinary Team meetings as required.
7. Maintain licensure through continuing education experiences as required.

Qualifications:

1. The ability to respond appropriately to the cultural differences present among the organization's service population and staff is required.
2. Ability to work well with others diplomatically in an effort to establish a positive relationship with partners both internally and externally.
3. Ability to set limits and maintain the helping role of the practitioner and to intervene appropriately to meet the needs of the persons served or other family members.
4. 2-5 years of experience working in the treatment and advocacy of children and families exposed to trauma.
5. Experience working with traumatized children.
6. Master's degree in social work, counseling, or related field; NC licensure required. LCSW strongly preferred.
7. Bi-Lingual/Spanish Speaking preferred.
